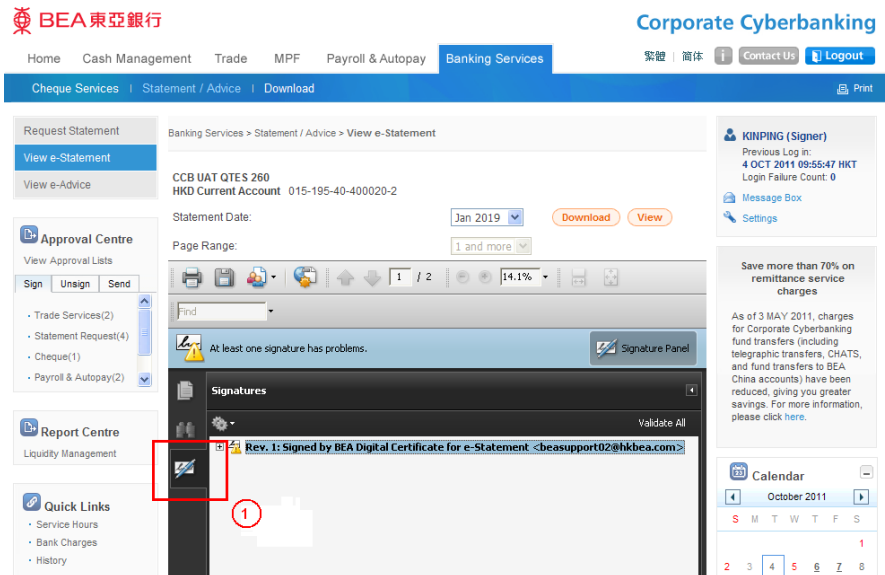


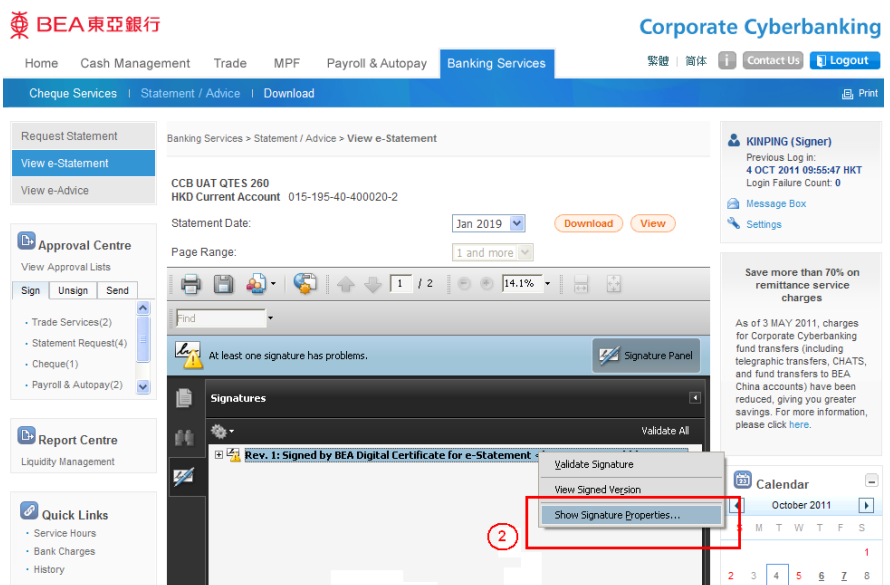
BEA Digital Certificate Download Demonstration

Follow these steps to download the BEA digital certificate to your Acrobat Reader:

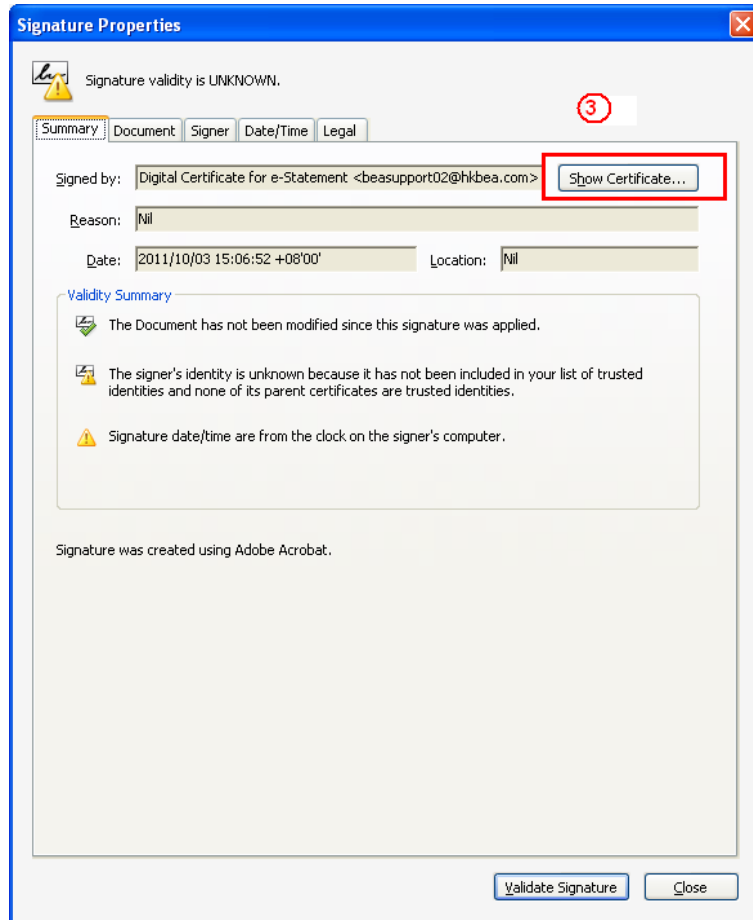
- 1 Click on the “Signatures” tab on the left-hand side of your Acrobat Reader. The signature details will then appear.



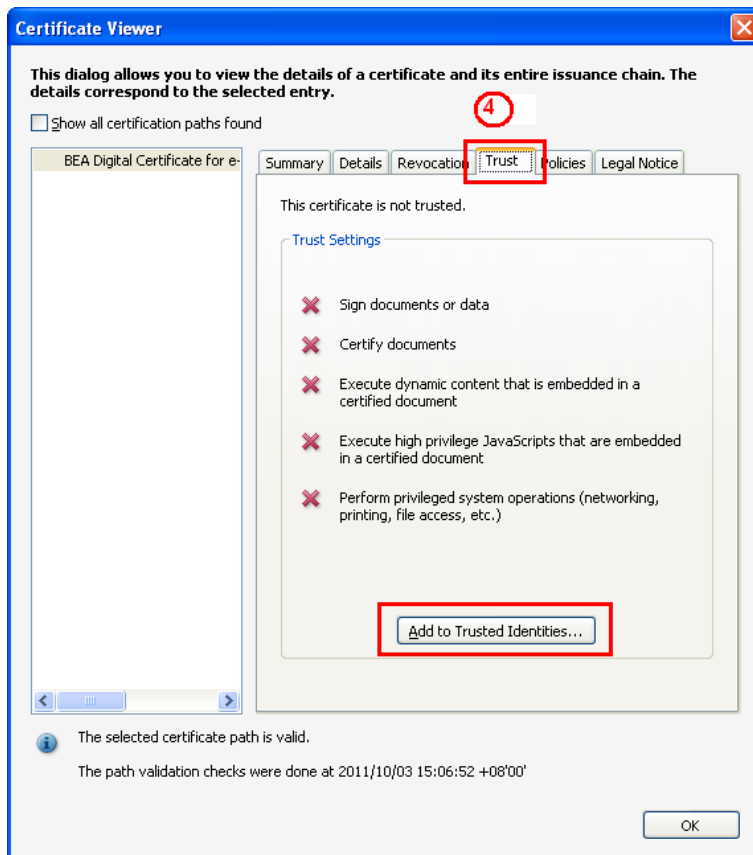
- 2 Right click “Signed by BEA Digital Certificate for e-Statement” under the signature details. A pop-up menu will then be displayed. Select “Show Signature Properties” in the menu. A “Signature Properties” window will appear.



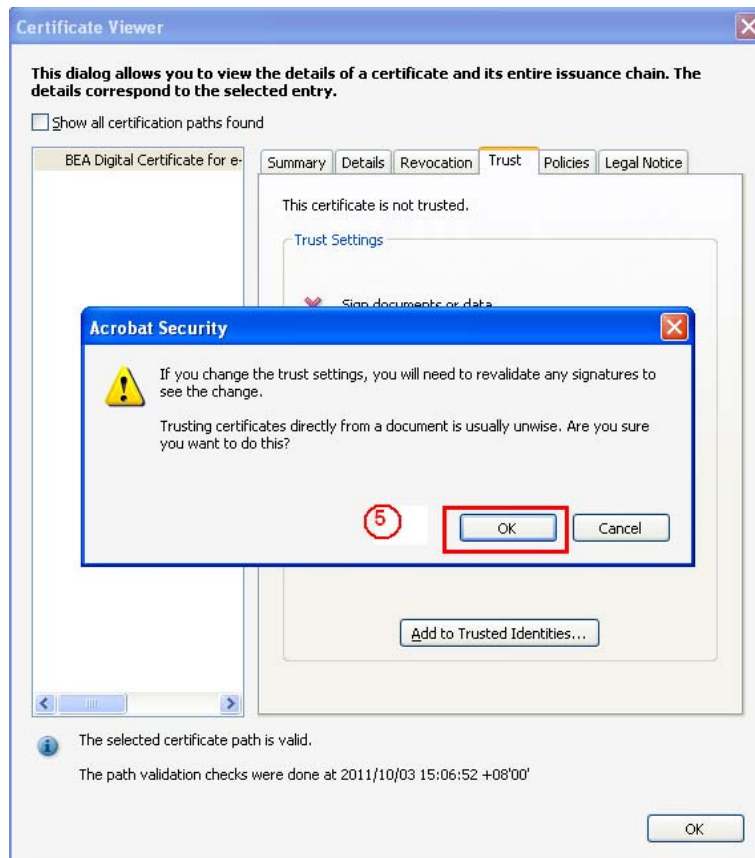
- ③ After verifying that this document is signed by The Bank of East Asia, click “Show Certificate” under “Summary”. A “Certificate Viewer” window will appear.



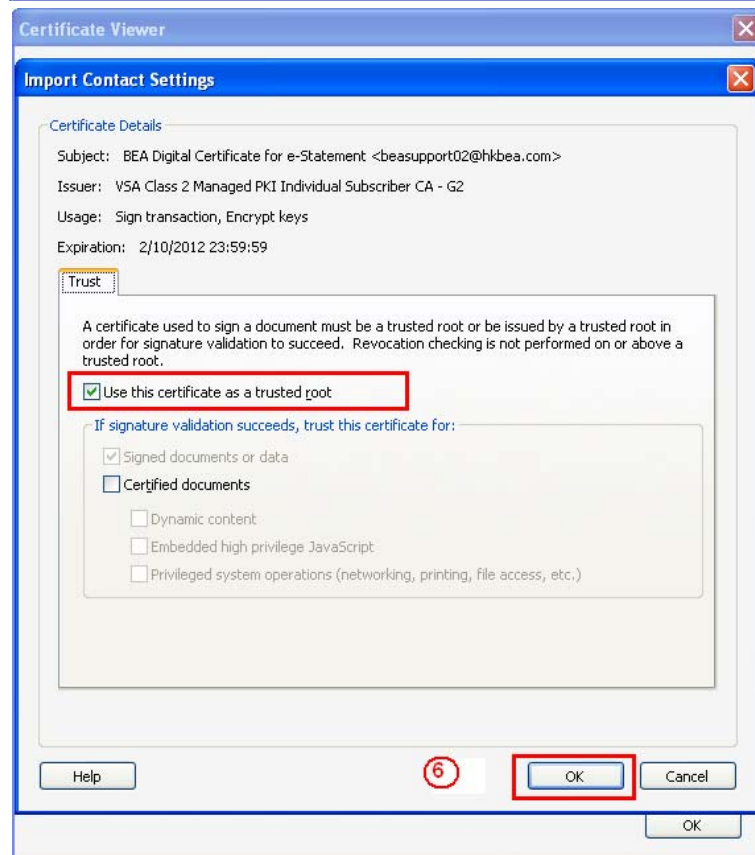
- ④ Select “Trust” in the menu and press “Add to Trusted Identities”. An “Acrobat Security” pop-up window will be displayed.




- 5 Click “OK” to confirm that you have verified the identity of the certificate. An “Import Contact Settings” pop-up window will be displayed.



- 6 Now proceed to import the certificate into your Acrobat Reader by selecting “Signatures and as a trusted root” and clicking “OK” to download the digital certificate.




- 7 Right click “Signed by BEA Digital Certificate for e-Statement” under the signature details again. A pop-up menu will be displayed. Select “Validate Signature” in the menu.
